THEME COURSES



Our thematic courses provide advanced beginner, intermediate and advanced students an opportunity to explore French culture through a specialized approach.

Pronunciation: Improve the quality of your spoken French. Covers basic phonetic rules, challenging sounds, liaison and intonation.

Literature: Improve speaking and comprehension while reading and analyzing French literary works from a wide variety of genres.

Conversation: Challenge your comprehension and speaking skills while covering current international events. This dynamic approach to French language and culture uses TV5 and RFI newscasts, as well as articles from "Le Monde," movie and book excerpts.

Literature & Cinema: Explore the interplay between film and literature and enhance your ability to understand, appreciate, and discuss works of literature and cinema. Study the transition from text to film by comparing selected novels with their film versions.



Let's speak French!: Build your French conversational skills through real-life situations, role plays, and skits.
(Prerequisite: FR-102)

Grammar: Elements of grammar are reviewed through structured practice. Topics vary depending on class needs..

Translation: Learn English-to-French translation techniques through articles and literary works. Develop a complete range of linguistic skills and master modern written and spoken French. (Open to level B2/C1)

Foreign Affairs: Using the newspapers, "Courrier International" and "Le Monde Diplomatique," review and discuss political matters and current events while improving your oral and written analytical and argumentative skills in French. (Open to level FR 204 and above)

Creative Writing: Improve and build on your vocabulary and idioms through various creative writing techniques and activities.
(Prerequisite: FR-204)

Business French: Tailor-made conversational business course in order to concentrate on a specific area of language in real-life business situations such as finance, business presentations, case studies, etc.

The **D.E.L.F.** (*Diplôme d'Études en Langue Française*) is an official qualification awarded by the French Ministry of Education to certify the competency of candidates in the French language. This diploma is valid for life. Visit our website for pricing based on exam levels.
